# “Blokes in Society” Men’s Day Award Categories

1) **To the Rescue** - Helps people out by fixing things

A Society is made up of people, who often rely on each other. This is a bloke who people turn to when something needs to be fixed, repaired or sorted out. Someone who helps others out of trouble.

2) **Solid Business** - Gives community stability through reliable service

In Society, businesses can do more than just make a profit. This bloke provides a product or service that people rely on everyday or at a critical moment. When you need them, you know they will be there.

3) **New Business** - Taking a risk for community growth and opportunity

A Society needs new businesses to grow. Very few things in business are certain. This bloke has taken a risk to start a business that fills a need, provides employment and growth potential. Because of his efforts, others will have opportunities to explore that they wouldn’t have if he hadn’t taken the risk.

4) **Community Caring** - Providing a much-needed service

This bloke does things in Society out of the goodness of his heart. He might only just cover his costs, but what he does is invaluable. Whether it is something everyone knows or a bit of a surprise, he thinks to do it, sometimes without being asked.

5) **Entertainer** - Provides a place or atmosphere for social engagement

A Society needs a place to come together. A bit of entertainment helps people relax and enjoy life. This bloke enables that to happen, either through providing people with a place with the right atmosphere or contributing to shared experiences.

6) **Health & Fitness** - Looking after the health and wellness of the community

Healthy people improve Society, through reduced sickness or injury and increased participation. This bloke knows that people are much closer to their best when they are fit, healthy and participating. He helps provide people with ways to do just that.

7) **CALD Leadership and participation**

Australian Society has been enriched through the presence of people from other cultures. Especially when blokes from these cultures engage and participate with the local community, and encourage their friends and family to join in.

8) **Indigenous Leadership and Participation**
